Celebrating New Development

Victory Station, Rockville, Maryland



Victory Housing is excited to be starting predevelopment on Victory Station, which will be located in Rockville, Maryland on a site awarded by Montgomery County. This planned development will be a 10-story affordable senior apartment community comprised of approximately 129,000 square feet with 104 one and two-bedroom apartments. The residents of this community will be 62 and older and have household incomes between 30% - 100% of area median income (AMI). Community features will boast a community room, a fitness center, a multipurpose room, a rooftop lounge for social programs and relaxing, and furnished patio areas with great views of the surrounding cityscape. Victory Housing corporate headquarters will be relocated to the new community.



Hampshire Village, Silver Spring, Maryland

From 2003 to recent, Victory Housing was a minority General Partner in Hampshire Village, an affordable senior apartment community with 110 two-bedroom apartments. In April 2023, Victory Housing exercised its option to purchase this community ensuring affordable rental rates continue for years to come. Residents at Hampshire Village are 62 and older with incomes at or below 50% of area median income (AMI). Twenty percent of apartments are set aside for very low-income seniors at 30% of AMI. Acquisition financing was provided by a team of lenders led by Montgomery County and including NHT Community Development Loan Fund and the Housing Partnership Fund. A special thank you to the County's DHCA for helping us to support and accelerate our mission to develop, acquire and operate affordable housing and services for low- to moderate-income seniors.
